## Re: Freedom of Information Act 2000 High-Intensity Focused Ultrasound

Thank you for your information request indicated in bold below, which has now been considered under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 by NHS Cheshire & Merseyside Integrated Care Board (ICB). I can provide you with the following information and responses.

Please note from 01 July 2022, Clinical Commissioning Groups (CCGs) were disestablished, and their statutory functions and responsibilities inherited by NHS Cheshire and Merseyside ICB.

## **Your Request:**

- 1) Is focal therapy using high-intensity focused ultrasound available as treatment for localised prostate cancer in your region, if so where?
- 2) If not, is it possible for patients who are deemed clinically suitable to have referral outside your region, and will their treatment cost be covered in full at a hospital outside the region where this treatment is offered?

## **Our Response:**

1 - 2) Focal therapy using high-intensity focused ultrasound as treatment for localised prostate cancer is not available within the Cheshire and Merseyside ICB region. The Cheshire & Merseyside Cancer Alliance have advised that currently it is not clear which patients would benefit/be clinically suitable or what the Oncological outcomes would be when compared with standard of care, as a consequence they are investigating participation in the PART Trial lead by Oxford University.
